

NYON GAMES LIBRARY - REGULATIONS

August 2017



MEMBERSHIP

There are three types of annual memberships, per family.

The membership is valid as of the day of enrolment and each time it is renewed. The member will receive a card, which, if lost, will be replaced for CHF 2.-. Special conditions are granted to grandparents who wish to rent games occasionally, to registered child-minders (Nyon) as well as childhood professionals (crèches, UAPE, speech therapists, etc.). Any other specific request has to be approved by the committee.

The games of the "giant games" group are excluded from the memberships.

LOANS

The number of games that can be borrowed is defined by the type of membership. The games can be chosen in any group (except for the giant games). Please note that only the group Playmobil is limited to one game per child. Exceptions are granted for festivities and birthday parties.

A rental fee, mentioned on each game, is charged per four-week loan, for the "Basic" membership. The member can renew the loan once for another 4 weeks; renewals can be requested by telephone or e-mail. The second loan will have to be paid on returning the game (for the "Basic" membership).

LATE RETURNS / REMINDERS

Games that are not returned on the date due will be subject, as of the next day, to a fine of CHF 1.- per game per week. Reminders will be sent by e-mail.

After the third reminder, the member will be charged the cost of the games as well as the fines.

DEPOSIT / COMPENSATION

Before leaving the games library, borrowers are expected to check that the items borrowed are complete and in good condition, with the help of staff if necessary. The user must return them in the same condition.

A deposit will be required if games are returned with parts missing (see rates posted at the library). The user has a month to return the missing part, even if he does not borrow anything else. If the part is not returned, the deposit will be kept in order to cover the replacement costs.

An appropriate compensation, also for the cases/plastic boxes, will be charged in case of damage to the games (other than normal wear and tear) or if a missing part cannot be replaced, rendering the game unfit for use.

USE OF THE PREMISES

When your children play with the games at their disposal, you are requested to put them back as soon as they have finished, so as to keep the room tidy and welcoming.

For security reasons, outdoor games and vehicles can only be rented. However, you may test them for size and functioning before you rent them.

The purpose of these premises is for on-the-spot playing. Eating is not permitted and you are requested not to use mobile phones, tablets or any other electronic device.

RESPONSIBILITY

While they are in the games library, parents or carers are responsible for the children.

Parents are responsible for the games rented by the family.

The games library accepts no responsibility for any damage incurred while using the games rented.

The games library committee reserves the right to ban anyone who does not follow the above regulations.
